This Super Sport convertible is equipped with the appropriate 396 cubic inch engine which is rated at 360 horsepower. The remainder of the drivetrain includes a four speed with a 4.10 rear end. Plans are to return the car to it's original Marina Blue paint in the future. The interior is matching Blue with a bench seat. In addition to regular detailing matters that have been done, Ken has replaced all the wiring harnesses from

front to rear. He very much enjoys driving this machine to car shows, cruises and anywhere else in between.

It gets "blown out" every so often, especially on the entrance ramps to the expressways. Plans are to take this Super Sport to the Nostalgia Drags on August 3, 2003 at Lancaster Raceway.
